The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is conducting a roadway study in Forest Hill, Everman, and Fort Worth to examine the issues and potential solutions on Forest Hill Drive between LonStephenson Road and Shelby Road. This study addresses flooding and stormwater impacts, roadway safety and traffic congestion. In addition, traffic signals are being upgraded, added, and re-timed on Forest Hill Drive near Interstate 20.

Please join us to hear the final recommendations and concepts developed following a public meeting held in September 2023. The public will be asked to review and comment on the recommendations. Additionally, construction funding approved by the Regional Transportation Council in February 2024 will also be discussed.
